If you are needing any school supplies, please contact our FRYSC Director, Brandon Uzzle, at 270-214-0914 and we can deliver school supplies to your home or you can schedule to pick them up at the Fulton County High School Westside Entrance #2.

On NTI days, we are providing meals. Meals will be available for pickup in front of Fulton County Elementary School between 10:30-11:30 a.m. as well as meals will be delivered by our transportation department. Busses will leave at approximately 10:30 a.m. from the school buildings and will drop off food using the afternoon student drop-off routes. For example, if it usually take 25 minutes after school for your child to arrive home, please allow that amount time for your food to be delivered. We are asking for your patience as we work out these details and if we fail to drop off a meal or you desire a meal, please call us at 270-236-3923 ext. 4122 or ext. 3000 and we will deliver a meal to you and add you to our route list.
